## Matheson House, home of the Perth Museum



The Perth Museum is celebrating 50 years in the Matheson House this year!

This popular tourist attraction, located downtown at 11 Gore Street East, is a National Historic Site. The stone dwelling was built in 1840 for the Honourable Roderick Matheson, wealthy merchant and a senator in Canada's first parliament after Confederation.

The Perth Museum is an excellent example of a small-town museum. The collections include archives, decorative and fine arts, natural sciences and furnished period rooms; reflecting the lifestyle of the Matheson family who owned the house for 90 years.

The Visitor Information Centre/Tourism Office is located at the back of the Perth Museum. Hours of operation for both are from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily between March and December; and close at 5 p.m. from January to March.

When you come to the Visitor Information Centre, staff will answer any questions you may have. You will find brochures, maps and information for your visit to the area. In the Gift Shop there is a beautiful selection of souvenirs and local books and items for sale. There are even public washrooms!
